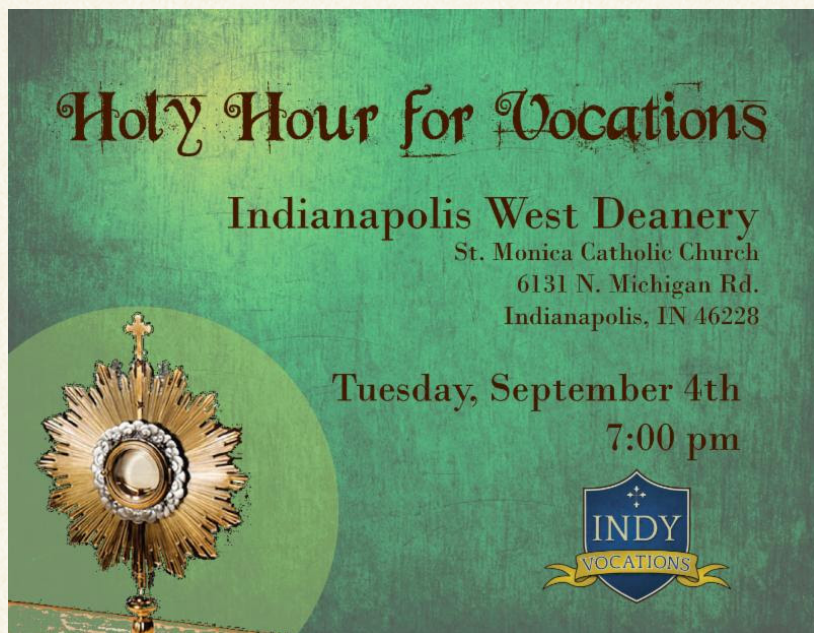
Words of Wellness
