- Register for the High School Placement Test (see below)
- Apply for admission at gocathedral.com/apply
 - Early Admission October 1 (receive decision by Thanksgiving!)
 - Regular Admission December 15
- Upload report cards and request recommendations
- Complete a student interview (scheduled after each application deadline)
- Apply for tuition assistance (if applicable) by December (gocathedral.com/tuitionassistance)
- Receive an admission decision
- Enroll in the Class of 2023!
