Stewardship Reflection

The fall is a time of changing leaves, settling into school routines, saying goodbye to summer and preparing for the winter months ahead. Here in the Archdiocese the fall is also a time of talking about “Stewardship” and things like appeals for the Archdiocese, envelopes for the Church, and making pledges of time, talent, and treasure.

Stewardship is a term frequently used in Christian Churches, whether they are Protestant or Catholic. I think it is important for us to begin to look at this term again and really see what it means for us. A dictionary defines stewardship as “the conducting, supervising, or managing of something; especially: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care.” This is a good understanding of the term but we must also understand what it means for us as Christians who see everything as gift. Archbishop Tobin's definition fills this out nicely by telling us that stewardship is “what we do with what we have when we

believe in God.”

As we move into the Fall think carefully about what you are doing with what you have and how it can be used to glorify God.

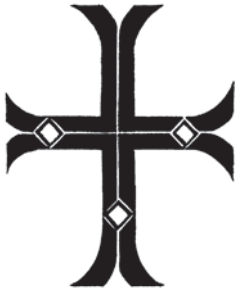
Reflexión de la Administración

La definición del Arzobispo Tobin complementa esto agradablemente diciéndonos que la administración es “lo que hacemos con lo que tenemos cuando creemos en Dios.”

Al entrar en el otoño piensa cuidadosamente que es lo que estás haciendo con lo que tienes y cómo puede ser usado para glorificar a Dios.

Update on the Unaccompanied Minors Program at St. Monica

The Office of Refugee Resettlement has not yet approved St. Monica as a site to host Bethany Christian Services transitional assistance program for unaccompanied minors. The numbers of unaccompanied children crossing into the U.S. greatly declined in July and August. Mexico has strengthened its border and is not allowing as many children to cross on their way to the U.S., and the U.S. has been sending messages to El Salvador, Guatemala, and Honduras warning them that unaccompanied children will most likely be deported. Congress did not pass President Obama's request for additional funds to deal with this issue. As a result of all of these events, the current Office of Refugee Resettlement shelters are now only about 60% full, and has not approved funding for the St. Monica site. Some believe that this slowdown is only temporary, and we will keep you posted as more information becomes available. — Father Todd

Noticias del Programa de los Inmigrantes Menores No Acompañados en Santa Mónica

La Oficina de Reasentamiento de Refugiados todavía no ha sido aprobada en Santa Mónica como un sitio para albergar el Programa de Asistencia de Transición Servicios Cristianos Betania para los Inmigrantes menores no acompañados. Los números de los niños no acompañados que cruzan la frontera a los Estados Unidos ha bajado mucho en Julio y Agosto. México ha asegurado más sus fronteras y no está permitiendo el cruce hacia los Estados Unidos, y los Estados Unidos ha mandado mensajes a El Salvador, Guatemala, y Honduras advirtiéndoles que los niños no acompañados serán deportados. El Congreso no pasó el pedido del Presidente Obama de aprobar los fondos para hacer frente a este problema. Como resultado de todos estos eventos, los refugios de la Oficina de Reasentamiento para Refugiados tienen una capacidad llena del 60%, y no han aprobado los fondos para el sitio de Santa Mónica. Algunos piensan que esta baja solo es temporal, le mantendremos informados al llegarnos más información. -Father Todd
