# 2011 Butler University Youth Football Camp

## What the camp provides

The Butler Youth Football Camp is administered and run by JV Football Camps, LLC and is open to players of all ability levels. The Butler University football staff will help coach the camp with an emphasis on the fundamentals of the game of football. A certified athletic trainer will be present during all physical activities. Small group instruction and drills will give each camper a fundamental understanding of all positions. General offense, defense and special teams concepts also will be covered. The objective of the camp will be to create an enthusiasm for the sport of football through a variety of enjoyable drills and contests. All participants will receive a Butler football camp T-shirt.

## General practice schedule

- Stretching and speed development drills
- Individual position drills for offense, defense and special teams
- Team drills for offense and defense
- Film sessions for offense, defense and special teams
- Football related games and contests

## What to bring

- Well marked youth football (If you own one)
- Football cleats and gym shoes
- Towel/sunscreen
- Water bottle/sack lunch
- Money for snacks (optional)

(This is not a padded camp. Campers will not wear any football equipment)

Walk ups are welcome but all fees must be paid in cash and all forms must be signed by parent or guardian before camper may participate.

## Registration

Initial registration will be complete when your camp fee, t-shirt form, and release agreement are signed and returned. Final registration will take place on the first day of each session from 8:30 to 9 a.m. at Gate 4 of Hinkle Fieldhouse. ## Arrival and departure

Roll call is taken every morning at 9 a.m. Camp will end each day at 3 p.m., Tuesday through Friday. Camp will officially end on Friday of each session at 3 p.m. Campers may be dropped off and picked up inside Gate 4 of Hinkle Fieldhouse.

## Fees

The fee is \$175 per camper required with return of the application. Campers must bring their own sack lunch.

- Family Rate: Bring a brother! The fee for two or more family member applications received in the same envelope is \$150 each.
- Butler Rate: The fee is \$150 for children of Butler University employees.
- Return Rate: A camper who would like to attend both sessions will be charged a \$150 fee for the second camp. The first session will still be \$175.

All checks should be made payable to JV Football Camps, LLC. Refunds are available up to 48 hours from the start of the session in which you are registered minus a \$50 processing fee.

## Camp Insurance

Parents are responsible for their camper's health insurance. JV Football Camps, LLC is insured by The Camp Team the sports insurance Specialist. Camp insurance is secondary to an injured party's primary health insurance. The policy will not cover deductibles, co-pays, program limits or out of network care. All claims must be filed within ninety days of the injury.

## RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration for being permitted to participate in JV Football Camps, LLC's 2011 Butler University Youth Football Camp ("Camp"), the parent or legal guardian of the minor participant named below ("Participant") hereby: (1) recognizes that there are certain dangers inherent in Participant's participation in the Camp; (2) RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES, and COVENANTS NOT TO SUE JV Football Camps, LLC, Butler University, and their officers, employees, and authorized representatives (all for purposes herein referred to as "Releasees") from all liability to the Participant, the undersigned, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin from any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands there from, on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the Participant immediately prior to, during, or immediately following Participant's participation in the Camp; and (3) HOLDS HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFIES the Releasees from and against all claims, actions, damages and expenses, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees, for any alleged injury and/or death to any person or damage to any property arising, or alleged to have arisen, out of any neglect, reckless or intentional act of the Participant or failure to act on the part of the Participant.
